To our valued guests, thank you for choosing to vacation with us during Summer 2021. We hope that you and your family are well and staying safe during these unprecedented times.

The novel Coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread by person-to-person contact, and as a result, federal and provincial governments and health agencies have recommended a number of measures to prevent infection, including social distancing, wearing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), and washing of hands.

We understand that you may be both excited and anxious about your upcoming stay, and we wanted to share the steps we have taken to ensure the safety and protection of all of our guests. As a result, the following steps have been implemented effective immediately:

Protecting Yourself and Others

- Stav home if:
 - You are feeling unwell, have a new cough, fever or other symptoms of COVID-19, or
 - You have travelled outside Canada in the past 14 days, or
 - You have been in contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days, or
 - You have been advised by a medical professional to self-isolate
- Wash your hands often and for at least 20 seconds with soap and water
- Practice physical distancing guidelines of at least 2 meters (6 feet) from others while utilizing any of the resorts amenities and activities

Cottages

- Each cottage will be sanitized prior to your stay with focus on high-touch areas such as handles, switches and remotes, as well as hard surfaces.
- It is recommended you bring your own sanitization products for the cottage/outdoor amenities.
- Pillows, pillowcases, sheets, blankets, comforters, towels and tea towels will not be provided. Please contact the cottage owner with respect to bed sizes.
- No visitors will be allowed at the resort. Only guests named in the agreement are allowed.
- Although pots, pans, dishes, glasses and cutlery are available for use, we recommend that you
 wash thoroughly prior to use, or bring your own reuseable/disposable kitchen items

Amenities and Activities

- The beach will be open and beach chairs will be made available.
- Some beach/water/lawn toys may be available, but we recommend bringing your own.
- Canoes, kayaks, paddle boards and boats, and oars will be available. They will be sanitized each Saturday. It is recommended that each guest self-sanitize before and after each use.
- Although PFDs (lifejackets) will be available for adults at the boathouse, they should be self-sanitized prior to/after each use.
- There will be no PFDs available for children or infants. Please arrange to bring your own.
- The basketball and volleyball courts are open and available for use. Some equipment may be available, but we recommend you bring your own (e.g. basketball, volleyball, etc.)
- The firepit will be open and available with limited seating. Fires will be permitted in the evening only and in use only in accordance with the local fire ban/restrictions.
- Picnic tables will be available for use. Please ensure that they are sanitized prior to/after use.
- Outdoor and water amenities, such as the playground, swings, water trampoline, dock, water slide and water mountain will be available with capacity limits in accordance with guidance.

The provincial government and local authorities are implementing changes regularly, which we are monitoring closely. We will attempt to keep you updated with respect to lifting/changing restrictions.

The implementation of the rules and restrictions are for your safety and for the benefit of all guests of the resort. While we hope that these steps will allow you to enjoy the resort, all amenities and activities are use at your own risk. We understand that these steps may differ from what you had originally planned, but hope that you understand the importance under these unprecedented circumstances.

Prior to your stay, all guests must acknowledge and agree to abide by the terms set out herein by signing and returning below, as well as the additional agreement that will be sent to you by your cottage owner. If you are unable to abide by these terms, please contact your cottage owner immediately to arrange cancellation.
